We have continued to welcome change and transformation!

There are small signs of growth.

The church is open on Fridays for private prayer and access to the food shelf which is supported financially by some congregation members and Robert Lucas Trust.

And we continue to support people in need with monies from the Robert Lucas Trust, and by referral to The Need Project.

Witness - e.g. We continued with the Easter Arch - the Noticeboard Nativity and the outdoor Town Carols which were particularly successful. Our Christmas Tree festival was back in church!

Several people undertook Dementia training, which raised awareness and works with the Town Council to achieve 'Dementia Friendly' status for the town .

We continue to reduce our carbon footprint by using a green gas supplier.

We have maintained an online presence through 9and9 on Facebook. 9and9 - has enabled us to pray together daily and been thought provoking and informative.

We continue to deliver Sunday service sheets to the housebound which also helps maintain pastoral relationships,

Attendance in Church is slowly rising as people grow more confident.

We have continued pastoral work through phone calls and doorstep visits, but progressively through "Coffee dates in local cafe's" and indoor home visits.

We have been using the Prayer Chain for intercessions

We have used WhatsApp to maintain contact

Community Cafe has been kept going through Zoom and then meeting in a local cafe. We have maintained involvement with Churches Together and Keith's Karaoke through Zoom.

Covid restrictions have limited what we have been able to do this year - we lost our food shelf - but continued to work through the Need Project.

Not being able to meet has meant that we could not progress the men's work.

The lack of computer facilities in our parish has meant that Discipleship has been constrained.

We have had to continually modify our responses to meet changing circumstances and guidelines - which we have done - but in some senses we are now where we thought we were a year ago
